1. Program Overview

Korean Government Scholarship Program (KGSP) began in September 2018 with the support of the the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport.

Through KGSP, you can understand various activities and policies on railway field. You will learn about the latest technological developments in high-speed rail and Korea's railway policies and management. It also aims to exchange the views on urgent issues related to the railway fields and strengthen future cooperation with Korea in global railway network and high-speed railway field.

By experiencing and learning about Korea's remarkable development throughout the stay, participants will gain considerable expertise and strengthen their analytical abilities. To enhance the effectiveness of the program, MOLIT is constantly cooperating with domestic universities to diversify the field and expand its budget.

2. Schedule of the 2025 Programs

In 2025, MOLIT will provide Master's Degree Program in Korean Government Scholarship Program for Oversea Government Railway Staffs in collaboration with Woosong University. Please find the attached file for the detailed information of the application schedule of the programs which will be started in the second half of 2025.

3. Recommendation of Applicants

MOLIT receives the recommendations of applicants from the government of its partner countries. There is no limit on the number of applicants each country can recommend. Woosong University selects applicants based on the recommendation and the result of selection procedure. Because MOLIT receives References, the applicant should submit an official letter of the government approving their nomination.

4. Application Eligibility

Applicants should

- Be a citizen of the Fellowship Program target country
- Be officially nominated by their government
- Be a government official or an employee in the public sector.
- Be a university/college graduate or have an equivalent educational background.
- Have sufficient command of both spoken and written English to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally.
- Have not previously received a scholarship from the Korean government.
- Not have previously participated in the program but withdrew due to failure to attain certain grades, violation of the training institute's rules, or submission of false information. Such individuals are not eligible to reapply for the Fellowship Program.

5. Selection Procedure

1) Selection Procedure

The Selection procedure will include two rounds: An evaluation of the application package by the university in Round 1, and a video or telephone interview with the University in Round 2. All the procedure will be conducted directly by university.

2) 1st round: An evaluation of the application package

The University will conduct the evaluation of application package and based on the result of the evaluation, the University will select applicants for the 2nd round.

3) 2nd round

Interviews will be conducted only for those who have passed the first round, and the university will contact the person individually to set an appointment for the interview.

The interview will be conducted in a location with a stable internet connection that supports video conferencing.

6. Notification of Final Nominees

When final nominee is selected, the Korean embassy will notify the individual. The University will also contact the nominees directly, and the information regarding departure will be distributed to the participants from university. Postponement of the enrollment is not allowed, in principle.

Note. Korean Government Scholarship Program includes a 'Country report' session where participants have an opportunity to analyze each country's current status and circumstances in the program subject and share it with other participants and Korean experts. It aims to provide appropriate solutions and insights to the identified problems and issues of their countries.

The country report should be in MS PowerPoint format. The length of the report should not exceed twenty A4-sized pages. The report should be written in English and double-spaced.

All participants are required to give a 15-minute presentation on their country report individually or as a group.

2. TOPICS TO BE COVERED IN THE COUNTRY REPORT

All participants will make an individual or group presentation titled "Country report" following the guidelines below:

A. Programs to provide education of highly professional experts who can lead the industry and research in advanced railway technology

- **Possible subject 1:** Status of railway industry and facing issues.
- **Possible subject 2:** Advanced railway technology status and status of professional education also technology development.
- **Possible subject 3:** Industry forecast of railway and relationship with Korean railway Industry

B. Details of Country Report Preparation**• National level service structure**

- Introduce your organization including personnel, main roles, and policy.
- Introduce your railway industry including scale of plant equipment, advanced railway technology, professional training in railway field.

• Strategic policies

- Describe government policies or guidelines on the above subjects. (Short-term or long-term plans: goals, priorities, strategies, etc.)

- Participants should cooperate in preventing any sexual harassment and attend a short training session regarding 'Sexual Harassment Prevention' on the first day of WSU orientation.

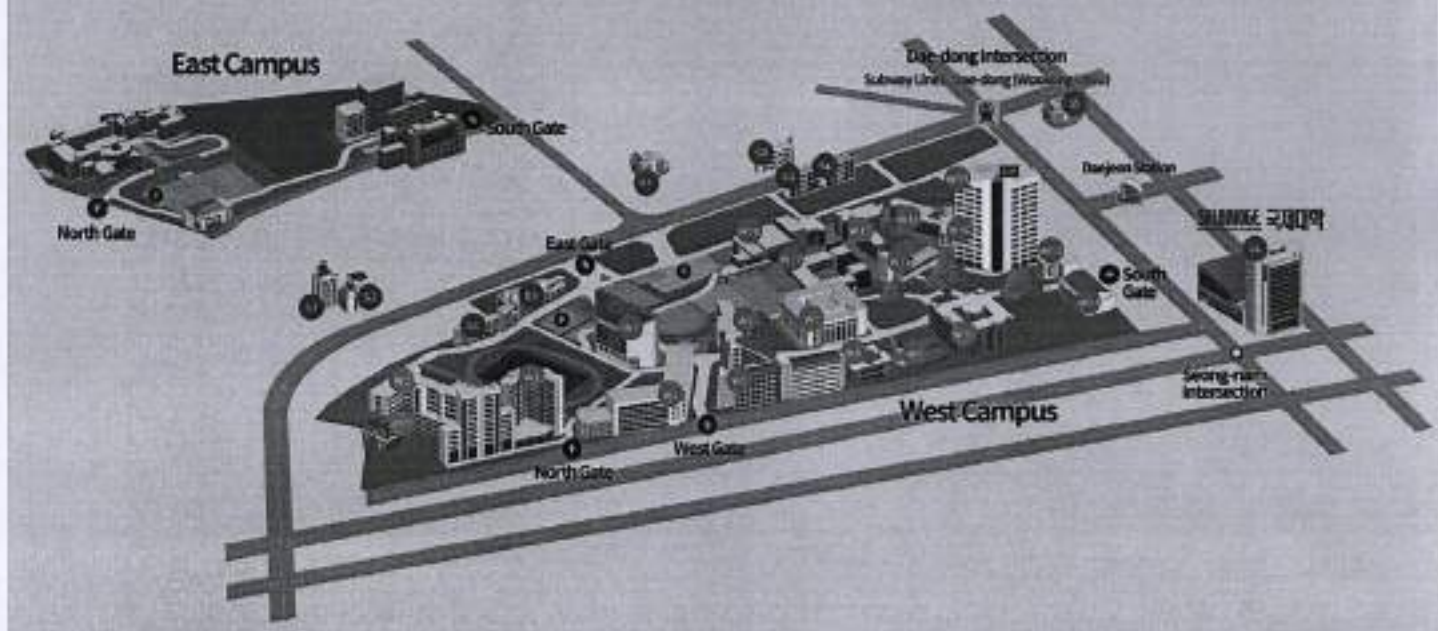
